SUZUKI METHOD TRAINING COURSE FOR THE TEACHING MANDOLIN HABILITATION - 1° DEGREE

General information: The complete training course includes five Levels that can be attended in five years. To be qualified to teach with the Suzuki Method it is necessary to reach the third level. Each level includes 120 hours of lessons with compulsory attendance and final exam.

Course duration: July 2021 - August 2022 (120 hours)

Study subjects: 1) Intensive study of Suzuki philosophy. 2) The progressive study of the qualifying technical points of the repertoire and teaching psychology. 3) Observation of lessons held by the teacher trainer and therefore at least 24 hours of practiced and guided apprenticeship. 4) Readings and debates on the development of the child, with particular regard to the parent / child relationship. 5) Individual performances of the studied repertoire.

PURPOSE: The multi-year teacher-training course is addressed to Conservatorium graduates and in particular, at all music teachers who intend to employ the Suzuki method for instrumental teaching to children.

Requirements: Conservatorium graduation or equivalent executive skills.

To apply for the course, it is necessary to send by 05/31/2021 a video with the following program:

Program: A.Vivaldi: an Allegro from a Mandolin Concerto;

R.Calace: to be chosen from among the preludes, Piccola Gavotta or Cielo Stellato;

A piece of your choice

Level exams will be held in August 2022, attendance is compulsory and admission to the exam is at the discretion of the teacher trainer.

Passing the Level exams entitles you to teach with the Suzuki methodology and to be enrolled into the ISI (Italian Suzuki Institute) and ESA (European Suzuki Association) registers.

SCHEDULE

The whole course will be held in a limited number, **upon compulsory reservation**, and in compliance with current legislation on the prevention of covid-19 infection, with the prevalence of outdoor activities. If the health emergency makes the course impossible, the deposit paid will be fully refunded.

The course provides:

- an 8-day summer workshop in Valle Grana from 7th to 14th July 2021 included, an integral part of the training with compulsory attendance with concert on Saturday 10th July in Pradleves (50 hours)
- Three meetings of about 7 hours each (dates to be agreed and distributed throughout the year with the teacher, possibly online). Can be held in Turin, Asti, Saluzzo.
- an 8-day summer apprenticeship in Valle Grana from 7th to 14th July 2022 (dates to be confirmed) included, an integral part of the training with compulsory attendance with final concert (50 hours)
- a minimum of 20 hours of listening to instrument lessons, preferably with your own Teacher Trainer. The listening hours can be carried out during the lessons of the annual courses and during the summer courses of a Suzuki school (it would be preferable to follow your Teacher Trainer in the course of the lessons)

In each workshop, there will be group and collective lessons where all the subscribers will attend and in some, the participation of young students with their families is expected.

At the end of the 2nd workshop, the enrolled teachers who have regularly attended the lessons will take the final 1st LEVEL exam, which is the same for everyone. There is also an individual verification for exam preparation.

If successful, the qualification diploma for teaching issued by ESA (European Suzuki Association) corresponding to the level achieved.

Recovery: in case you cannot be present at a meeting, it is possible to arrange a free recovery of 3 hours. For any other recoveries the cost will be € 20.00 per hour for a maximum of 3 hours.
