EXPA 2023 _ MANDOLIN TRAINING COURSE

SUZUKI METHOD TRAINING COURSE FOR THE ESA MANDOLIN HABILITATION Levels 1 & 2

General information: The complete training course includes five Levels that can be attended in five years. To be qualified to teach with the Suzuki Method it is necessary to reach the third level. Each level includes 120 hours of lessons with compulsory attendance and a final exam.

Course duration: May 2023 - March 2024 (120 hours)

Objects of study: 1) Intensive study of Suzuki philosophy

2) The progressive study of the qualifying technical points of the repertoire and teaching psychology. 3) Observation of lessons held by the teacher trainer and therefore at least 24 hours of practiced and guided apprenticeship.

4) Readings and debates on the development of the child, with particular regard to the parentchild relationship.

5) Individual performances of the studied repertoire.

PURPOSE: The multi-year teacher-training course is addressed to Conservatory graduates but no less to all music teachers who intend to employ the Suzuki method for teaching children.

Requirements: for Suzuki levels 1 & 2:

1) mandolin degree

2) Other degrees or diplomas equivalent to the mandolin degree

3) Mandolin course attendance at a Conservatory of music or at an equivalent School

4) Diploma or Suzuki qualification (at least level 3) on another plucked instrument or violin (Conversion).

To apply for the course (point n. 2-3-4), it is necessary to send by April 30th 2023 a video with the following program:

Program: A.Vivaldi: an Allegro from a Mandolin Concerto;

R.Calace: a composition to be chosen from among the preludes, Piccola Gavotta or Cielo Stellato;

A piece of your choice

Level exams will be held in March 2024. Attendance is compulsory and admission to the exam is at the discretion of the teacher trainer.

Passing the Level exams entitles you to teach with the Suzuki methodology and to and ESA (European Suzuki Association) registers.

SUZUKI METHODOLOGY EXPERIMENTAL COURSE OF VIOLIN-MANDOLIN CONVERSION

General information: The training course of CONVERSION FROM THE SUZUKI VIOLIN TO THE SUZUKI MANDOLIN is aimed to Suzuki violinists who have achieved the ESA level 2 and who intend to learn the methodology on the mandolin. The one-year course will develop the mandolin technique and its methodology. At the end, the Suzuki mandolin level I recognized by the ISI and the ESA (Experimental) will be achieved. To continue the subsequent levels, it will be necessary to deepen the study of the mandolin in a Conservatory or equivalent school, proving to know and correctly perform the repertoire of the relative mandolin level.

The course includes 120 hours of lessons with compulsory attendance and final exam.

Course duration: May 2023 - March 2024 (120 hours)

Study subjects: 1) Acquisition of the mandolin technique

2) The progressive study of the qualifying technical points of the repertoire and teaching psychology. 3) Observation of lessons held by the teacher trainer and therefore at least 24 hours of practiced and guided internship

- 4) Group exercises in a mandolin ensemble
- 5) Individual performances of the studied repertoire

PURPOSE: The conversion course is aimed to Conservatory violin graduates who have developed a basic technique on the mandolin that will be deepened in the year of conversion. The course will be structured with 5-6 meetings during the year, the summer course or group lessons and 20 observation lessons, where the technical aspect of the mandolin will be deepened.

Requirements: Violin Degree/Diploma from a Conservatory or equivalent school, and basic playing skills on the mandolin.

To apply for the course, it is necessary to send a video of one or more pieces played on the mandolin with a maximum duration of 10 minutes **by 04/30/2023**.

The Level I exam will be held in **March 2024** attendance is mandatory and admission to the exam is at the discretion of the teacher trainer.

Passing the Level I exam entitles you to practice teaching mandolin with the Suzuki methodology within a Suzuki school and to be enrolled in the I.S.I. (Italian Suzuki Institute) and ESA (European Suzuki Association).

SCHEDULE

The course provides:

- an 6-day summer workshop, with a final concert, in the city of Saluzzo, Italy, at the "Chitarrissima" event, August 23rd-27th 2023, which will be an integral part of the teacher training program, with compulsory attendance.

- three meetings of about 7 hours each (dates to be agreed with the teacher trainer and distributed throughout the year, possibly online). Meetings can be held in the cities of Turin, Asti or Saluzzo.

- a minimum of 20 hours of listening to instrumental lessons, preferably with your own Teacher Trainer. The listening hours can be carried out during the lessons of the annual courses and during the summer courses of a Suzuki school (it would be preferable to follow your Teacher Trainer in the course of the lessons)

In each workshop, there will be group and collective lessons attended by all the subscribers. In some ot them, the participation of young students with their families is expected. At the end of last workshop, the enrolled teachers who have regularly attended the lessons will take the final LEVEL 1 or Level 2 exam. There is also an individual verification for exam preparation.

If the exam will be successful, the teacher trainee will be granted of the ESA (European Suzuki Association) certificate, corresponding to the level achieved.

Recovery: in case you cannot be present at a meeting, it is possible to arrange a free recovery of 3 hours. For any other recoveries, the cost will be \notin 20.00 per hour for a maximum of 3 hours.

The detailed course program will be provided directly by the teacher upon enrollment.
